- We will be presenting Knots & Lashings. BE PREPARED! Study your knots and bring your Scout Handbook. Use the EDGE method when demonstrating knots to the Webelos. We plan to build a Trebuchet as our Pioneering project.
- Annual Troop XV Cooking Contest!! This year's theme is Iron Chef Style with a secret ingredient.
- All patrols, please organize your personal gear, tents, and meals (Saturday breakfast and dinner will be cooked and [Saturday Lunch and Sunday Breakfast should be no cook](#)).
- Sunday: Scouts working on First Class Rank will need to stay to complete the 1-mile orienteering course.
- Scouts, remember to reimburse your driver for gas money.
