

Summer Camp Scheduling Guidelines

General Information: Circle Ten Summer Camps offer a variety of merit badges, a Trail to First Class program for younger Scouts, and more advanced courses for older Scouts. Please refer to the Camp Leader Guide for each camp along with the Detailed Course Offerings report (drop down menu on the CampMaster event page) to gain additional information about each camp and courses.

Course Offerings: Courses are offered in the morning at 9:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 11:00 AM. Following lunch, courses are offered at 2:00 PM and 3:00 PM. Some courses are 1 hour in duration, others are 2 hours in duration, and a few last all day (5 hours).

Course Selection: Scouts should select the courses they need for rank advancement and courses that are interesting and fun. However, they should pay attention to recommended rank and any BSA age restrictions.

Scheduling: The new version of CampMaster builds schedules automatically based on selection of desired courses in order of priority. Courses are listed in the dropdown lists based on the currently planned schedule. The second dropdown list is populated with courses which are currently possible based on taking the first selected course. The third list based on the first two and so on. This selection process avoids displaying mutually exclusive course combinations.

Please note that the scheduling team will be monitoring request volume of courses and may adjust the number of course occurrences based on demand. If significant changes are made you will receive an alert message.

Open Times: It is not necessary to schedule Open Times. Open times are scheduled at 4:00 PM every day, giving Scouts the flexibility to go to any of the Areas, work on merit badges that may need extra time, participate in Troop activities, or just have FUN.

Block Out Times: Some Scouts may want to block out specific times in the morning and the 2 hours in the afternoon. They should select as their 1st choice the **Free Time** course offerings. This will reduce their choices of courses. Refer to **Scheduling** above.
